MANAGER

As **Managers**, physicians are integral participants in healthcare organizations, organizing sustainable practices.

PROFESSIONAL

As **Professionals**, physicians are committed to the health and well-being of individuals and society through ethical practice, profession-led regulations, and high personal standards of behavior.
