Potential Questions: Interviewing a Medical Supervisor

- 1. How long have you known this physician?
- 2. What is your professional relationship with this physician?
- 3. What is your personal relationship with this physician?
- 4. How would you describe this physician as a person?
- 5. Have any patients made comments to you about this physician? Please explain.
- 6. Describe your comfort level working with this physician or having him/her on hospital staff?
- 7. How does this physician respond in an emergency or critical situation?
- 8. How does this physician respond in stressful situations?
- 9. How would you compare this physician's medical knowledge to that of other physicians with whom you work/consult?
- 10. What do you see as this physician's greatest strength(s)?
- 11. What changes (if any) would you recommend this physician make?
- 12. Describe the accessibility of this physician when you wish to make an urgent patient referral?
- 13. If you had a patient present with a problem in this physician's area of expertise, would you feel comfortable referring your patient to this physician?
- 14. Does this physician ask for advice or help when appropriate?
- 15. Can you describe a case you feel this physician handled particularly well?
- 16. Can you describe a case you feel this physician could have handled better or differently?
- 17. How receptive is this physician to suggestions or input from other staff members?
- 18. Do you have any knowledge about how this physician keeps up to date on changes in medical treatments, procedures or knowledge?
- 19. Do you feel this physician is practicing in a safe manner?
- 20. If you had a family member who was seriously ill, would you be comfortable with this physician caring for him/her?
- 21. If you had a family member who was dying, would you be comfortable with this physician as the most responsible physician caring for him/her?

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Potential Questions: Interviewing Residents/Students

- 1. What is your relationship to this physician?
- 2. How long have you known this physician and how many weeks/months have you worked directly with him/her?
- 3. Is this physician readily available to provide assistance when requested? Does he/she create an atmosphere where such requests are welcomed and encouraged? Can you explain how he/she does this?
- 4. Do you feel this physician assigns you an appropriate degree of responsibility given your level of training? If yes, please give examples/explain this? If no, can you suggest reasons why?
- 5. Does this physician meet with you regularly to review your assessment, management decisions, and documentation of patient care? If yes, how often? Is it in a comfortable/private setting? If no, do you have any opportunity for a review?
- 6. Does this physician meet with you regularly to provide meaningful feedback on your clinical competence and acquisition of knowledge? Please elaborate.
- 7. Does this physician create and maintain a professional supervisor-trainee relationship at all times?
- 8. Do you have any concerns about this physician in his/her role as a clinical supervisor? Please explain.
- 9. In your opinion, does this physician serve as a role model of appropriate and compassionate patient care?
- 10. Have patients made any comments to you about this physician? Please explain.
- 11. How would you compare this physician's medical knowledge and supervisory approach compared to other physicians that you have worked with?
- 12. How does this physician respond in an emergency situation?
- 13. What changes (if any) would you recommend this physician make?
- 14. What would you describe as this physician's greatest asset?
- 15. Would you recommend this physician to care for a family member?

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
