He has not been supportive during her cancer experience and will often make excuses of why he cannot attend appointments or provide support. Right now, she is trying to focus on the support she does have and remain hopeful.

Debra does not consider herself religious at this time, however, she is in the process of trying to understand and learn more about spirituality. After being diagnosed with cancer and receiving treatments, it has opened her mind to other values and beliefs. She isn't sure if it will help yet but is willing to give it a try.
